

# EARLY-LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS

## Pre-K Standards

### Math

- **MD1:** Children will begin to develop an understanding of numbers
- **MD2:** Children will create and duplicate simple patterns
- **MD3:** Children will sort and classify objects

### Social & Emotional

- **SE1:** Children will develop confidence and positive self-awareness
- **SE2:** Children will develop curiosity, self-direction and persistence
- **SE3:** Children will increase the capacity for self-control
- **SE4:** Children will develop interpersonal and social skills for relating with other members of the learning community

### Language

- **LD1:** Children will develop skills in listening for the purpose of comprehension
- **LD3:** Children will develop an understanding of new vocabulary introduced in conversations, activities, stories or books
- **LD4:** Children will develop and expand expressive language skills (speaking)
- **LD5:** Children will begin to develop age-appropriate strategies that will assist in reading

### Science

- **SD1a:** Asks questions about objects, organisms, or events in environment
- **SD1b:** Uses senses to observe, classify, and learn about objects
- **SD1c:** Uses language to describe observation
- **SD1d:** Uses simple equipment to experiment, observe, and increase understanding
- **SD1f:** Predicts what will happen next based on previous experience
- **SD3:** Children will acquire scientific knowledge related to physical science
- **SD3c:** Investigates different types/speeds of motion

### Creative Development

- **CD2a:** Uses music and movement to express thoughts, feelings, and energy
- **CD2b:** Participates in group singing or other musical activities
- **CD2c:** Participates in creative movement and dance
- **CD3a:** Participates in dramatic play to express feelings, dramatize stories, reenact real-life roles and experiences
- **CD3c:** Participates in activities using symbolic materials and gestures to represent real objects and people
